### **Hodgman electorally premature**

Statement from Duncan Kerr on the AEC's 2008 Proposed Redistribution of Tasmania:

The AEC's proposed decision to deny renaming the Federal Electorate of Denison in honour of one of Australia's greatest founding fathers will leave many more people disappointed rather than pleased.

It was curious to see the State Member for Denison, Mr Hodgman, celebrate this decision.

While the State Member may look for any excuse to open a 'Royal Vintage Cascade Blue', he might note that this is simply a proposed redistribution and a final decision has not been made.

Amongst other tremendous accolades and testimonies, Andrew Inglis Clark was named as the 'primary architect of the Australian Constitution' by former High Court Justice and Governor-General Sir William Deane.
